Hearing was conducted today through Video Conferencing on Cisco Webex Meeting Platform facilitated by Ahlmad of the Court.


Accused K.A. Kanekar, Kishore Aggarwal, Rajat Verma & Sanjay Kapasia have already submitted their signed written statements in answer to the questionnaires supplied to them U/s 313 Cr. PC. Today, all the four accused have affirmed their signatures on each page of their respective statements. This shall be taken as sufficient compliance of the provisions of Section 313 Cr. PC in view of Sub Section 5 of the said Section.

Sh. Abhishek Prasad, Advocate submits that on account of acute illness of accused A-1, A-2, A-4 & A-8, they could not go through the questionnaires supplied to them by this

court. He seeks some more time for preparing replies to the questionnaires supplied to these accused. Accordingly, the statements of these four accused namely Sri Chand, Anna Wankhede, S.P Saxena and Narayan Diwakar shall now be recorded on 07.09.2020.
